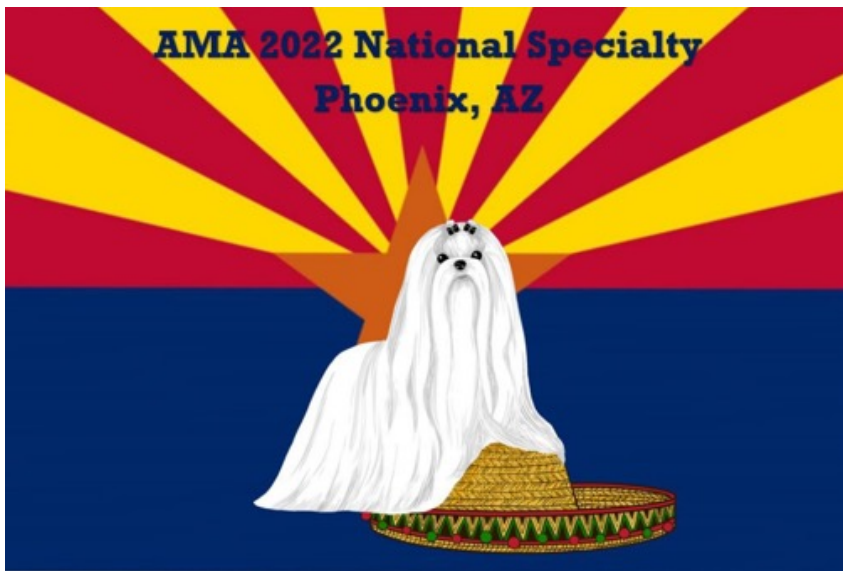

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

From East:

- Take I-10 West which will merge with I-17 North. Look for the signs to Flagstaff
- Stay on I-17 for approximately 8 miles. Take the Dunlap Avenue Exit
- The hotel is at the northeast corner of Dunlap and I-17 (2620 West Dunlap Avenue)

From North

- Take Interstate 17 South (towards Phoenix)
- Take the Dunlap Avenue Exit
- The hotel is on the northeast corner of Dunlap and I-17 (2620 West Dunlap Avenue)

From West

- Take I-10 East which will merge with I-17 North
- Proceed north approximately 15 miles to the Dunlap Avenue Exit
- Cross over Dunlap Avenue (the first light after taking the exit)
- Turn right after the first light onto the property
- The hotel is located at the northeast corner of Dunlap Ave and I-17 (2620 W Dunlap Ave)

From Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport

- Take Interstate 10 North, which will turn to the west
- Continue to I-17 North and travel approximately 7 miles
- Take the Dunlap Ave Exit, and the hotel is on the northeast corner (2620 W Dunlap Ave)

PET POLICY: Pets are allowed to stay as guests of the Sheraton Crescent Hotel.

All Pet Owners with Dogs must sign Pet Waiver/No Pet Fee –Maximum of 4 dogs per room.

Notice of number of dogs in room at check-in.

Dogs are not allowed in any restaurant or lounge.

Dogs will not be left unattended in sleeping rooms for an extensive amount of time. This is to assure the safety of the dog and to cause minimal disruption to other guests and pets.

All dogs must be crated if left in sleeping room unattended.

Dogs must be under complete control of owner at all times.

Random Spot Checks of exhibitor rooms may be made by AMA officers and/or designated Specialty Room monitor.

Any exhibitor who allows his or her dogs to be loose or unattended in a room or allows their dogs to do damage to hotel property and who does not immediately contact the hotel management to make proper restitution, will be subject to Event Committee action, which could result in the loss of American Kennel Club Privileges and fine.

The Show Committee reserves the right to retain Event Committee jurisdiction over exhibitors whose names have been referred by hotels/motels as having left their rooms and/or grounds in a state that appears negligent or offensive.

Each person is responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.

Plastic must be placed under dog crates in hotel rooms.

All complaints regarding conduct prejudicial to the sport will be dealt with in accordance with AKC rules by the Event Hearing Committee.

RV PARKING RULES AND RATES

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge’s book, steward’s book & the catalog. Professional handlers,* household members and current assistants to professional handlers** may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition.



Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOGS, 7 YRS. & OLDER VETERAN BITCHES, 7 YRS. & OLDER

Spayed bitches and neutered dogs are eligible to compete in Veterans. Winners of each Veterans class, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

STUD DOG & BROOD BITCH CLASS: Each entry is allowed two get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

BRACE CLASS: Two Maltese with at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The two dogs in the unit MUST be identified at the time of entry. The information for each dog entered in the Brace Class must be filled out on individual entry forms. Only one entry fee is charged per unit. If more than one Brace unit is entered by the same owner, the entry form for each dog must indicate Brace 1, Brace 2, etc.

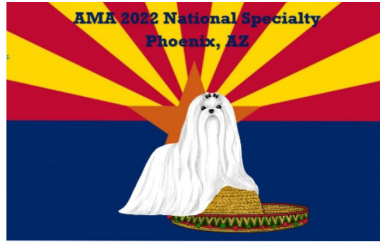


AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks.
